Narrative Description of Indicator

Because no due process hearing requests were filed in FFY 2009, there was no opportunity for a resolution session to occur MSDE will continue to work with the Office of Administrative Hearings to ensure that Part B policies, procedures, and time followed when parents file a request for due process under Part C of IDEA. The MSDE amended COMAR 13A.13.01.00 in Ju for the purpose of the Maryland Infants and Toddlers Program adopting the mediation and due process procedures in 34 CF 300.506 through 300.512 and developing procedures that meet the requirements of Sec. 303.425. The Part B procedures v adopted by Part C on 10/5/2009.
