Local Infants and Toddlers Program Results for Early Intervention Services

Maryland: Indicator 3

Percent of infants and toddlers with IFSPs who demonstrate improvement.

Narrative Description of Indicator

To report the percent of infants and toddlers with IFSPs who demonstrated improvement for FFY 2010, MSDE generated a report from the statewide Part C database comparing the status-at-entry and status-at-exit data on infants and toddlers who exited the program between 7/1/10 and 6/30/11 and who participated in the MITP for at least 6 months. Data from about 2,100 children for each of the child outcome components were computed into the 2 summary statements required by the Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP):

Summary Statement #1 — Of those infants and toddlers who entered early intervention below age expectations in each outcome, the percent who substantially increased their rate of growth by the time they turned 3 years of age or exited the program.

Summary Statement #2 – The percent of infants and toddlers who were functioning within age expectations in each outcome by the time they turned 3 years of age or exited the program.

For FFY 2010, slippage from the 2009 data was noted and the results were lower than the State target for each outcome. In FFY 2010, progress data on children receiving services on the Extended IFSP Option were reported for the first time.
