Narrative Description of Indicator

The least restrictive environment (LRE) data for this APR are based on Maryland's 618 annual child count collected the last Friday in October 2018 and reported in the 2018 Maryland Special Education/Early Intervention Services Census Data and Related Tables document. The MSDE has made progress in all Indicator 5 subsets. Each subset of the indicator has demonstrated growth over time and maintains a positive trend.

The Indicator 5 subsets are 5A, 5B, and 5C:

- 5A Percent of children with IEPs, aged 6 through 21, served inside the regular class 80% or more of the day.
- 5B Percent of children with IEPs, aged 6 through 21, served inside the regular class less than 40% of the day.
- 5C Percent of children with IEPs, aged 6 through 21, served in separate schools, residential placements, or homebound or hospital placements.

Other Data for this Indicator

<u>View Indicator 5A</u> - During the school year 2018 - 2019, 70.20% of students received services inside regular education 80% or more of the day. This data represents continued progress. These data reflect an increase from the FFY 2017-2018 data of 70.09%. The State did not meet the target of 70.90%.

<u>View Indicator 5B</u> - During the school year 2018- 2019, 12.06% of students received services inside regular education less than 40% of the day, which is an increase from the result obtained in 2017-2018 of 12.04%. This percentage did not meet the State's target of 10.76%. Although the target has not been met, the percentage of children served in this type of placement has deceased over time.

<u>View Indicator 5C</u> - During the school year 2018 - 2019, 6.85% of the state's students with disabilities received services in separate schools, reflects a slight increase from the FFY 2017-2018 data of 6.77%. . This percentage did not meet the State's target of 5.44%. Although the target has not been met, the percentage of children served in this type of placement has decreased over time
