Narrative Description of Indicator

Local school systems and public agencies reported a total of 15 out of 1,837 students, or 0.82%, whose eligibility determination or IEP development did not occur by the third birthday, as having "Acceptable Reasons for Delay." Acceptable Reasons for Delay include "Parent & IEP Team have a written agreement to extend the timeline"; and, "Parent repeatedly failed or refused to make child available," and "School/Facility Closure."

The range of days beyond the third birthday for eligibility determination or development and implementation of the IEP for all reasons cluster around the following ranges:

- 16 to 35 days - 15
